Bead Head Dazzle Leech



Hook: 10-6 nymph
Thread: 6/0 black
Tail: Black marabou
Body: Black Dazzle dubbing with red
Head: Black bead
Note: Can be tied with various colors of dazzle dubbing.

Tying Instructions:

- Slide a bead head on to hook before placing it in the vice.
- Secure thread on to hook, and wrap back to hook bend.
- Tie in marabou tips for tail. Tail should be about half the length of hook shank.
- Dub the dazzle dubbing on to thread, and wrap thread forward to bead head.
- Whip finish, and head cement.
- Finally, Use a bodkin to pull out dubbing to desired thickness.

Bent Leech



Hook: 10-6 Mustad 9672, front half bent up 45 degrees

Thread: 6/0 black

Tail: Black marabou

Body: Black seal fur picked out

Weight: Lead wire on front half

Note: Can be tied in others colors such as olive, brown, and maroon.

Tying Instructions:

- Place hook in vice, and bend the front half up 45 degrees.
- Wind lead wire on the front half of hook and secure in place with thread. Wrap thread back and forth over lead until it is no longer visible.
- Tie in marabou as tail at hook bend, tail should be about half the length of hook shank.
- Dub seal fur on to thread and wrap forward to eye of hook.
- Whip finish, and head cement.
- Use a bodkin to pull out seal fur.

Gew Leech

Hook: 10-6 Nymph
Thread: 6/0 Black
Tail: Black Marabou
Body: Green Crystal Chenille
Hackle: Black saddle (long)

Tying Instructions:

- Wrap thread to bend of hook, and tie in a short piece of marabou.
- Next, fold 2 black saddle hackle fibers and tie them in by their tips. Make sure they are facing the same way.
- Tie in crystal chenille.
- Wrap thread forward to eye of hook and then wrap chenille forward to eye of hook, secure with thread then trim.
- The next step is to wrap the saddle hackle forward. Wrap both pieces at the same time. The easiest way to do this is by placing the other end of the hackle fibers in hackle pliers to keep them flush. Then wrap the hackle forward. Stroking fibers back after each wrap.
- Tie off hackle at eye of hook, whip finish, and head cement.
- Lastly, stroke hackle fibers back.

Marabou Leech



Hook: TMC 300, Mustad 79580, sizes 4-8

Thread: 6/0 Black

Tail: Black and maroon marabou

Body: Black chenille

Wing: Black and maroon marabou with a few strands of black krystal flash.

Note: Can be tied in many other colors such as solid black, maroon, olive, or brown.

Tying Instructions:

- Wrap thread back to hook bend and tie in black marabou for tail.
- Tie in maroon marabou over top of the black marabou.
- Tie in black chenille, wrap thread forward, leaving enough room to tie in wing.
- Wrap chenille forward for body, and secure with thread.
- Tie in maroon marabou. Tips should extend back to end of tail.
- Tie in black chenille over maroon chenille, both should be approximately the same length.
- For added flash, you can tie in a few strands of krystal flash on either side of marabou.
- Trim excess marabou and krystal flash, whip finish, and head cement.

Micro Leech

Hook: #8-12

Thread: 8/0

Tail: Burgundy Marabou

Body: Burgundy Dazzle Dubbing

Bead: Small Gold, optional

Tying Instructions:

- Place bead on hook and secure in place, start by tying in short fluffy piece of marabou at the bend of the hook for the tail.
- Dub a thick body along the entire shank. Whip finish.
- Brush out the dubbing to complete the fly.

Peacock Chenille Leech



Hook: 10-6, Streamer
Thread: 6/0 Black
Tail: Black Marabou
Body: Plastic Peacock or Crystal Chenille
Head: Copper Bead.

Tying Instructions:

- Slide copper bead on to hook before placing on vice.
- Tie in black marabou at hook bend. Tail should be no more than 3/4 the shaft length.
- Trim excess marabou and tie in your peacock chenille and wrap thread up to your bead.
- Wrap chenille forward to bead, secure with thread, trim excess, whip finish, and head cement

Rabbit Strip Leech



Hook: 8 or 6 Streamer

Thread: 6/0 black

Tail: Black rabbit strip

Body: Black rabbit strip rapped

Note: Can be tied in black, maroon, olive, and brown.

Tying Instructions:

- Tie in rabbit strip for tail. For the tail, tie in by the fur not by the skin.
- Tie in another rabbit strip by the skin for the body.
- Wrap the rabbit strip along hook shank pulling hair back as you wrap. Make sure each wrap of rabbit strip lays flush to the last wrap of rabbit strip.
- Secure rabbit strip with thread, whip finish and head cement.

Rubber Leg Bugger

Hook: #2 - 10
Thread: 8/0 Olive
Tail: Marbou
Body: Chenille
Legs: Fine Rubber Legs
Hackle: Saddle Hack
Bead: Optional 5/32 Gold

Tying Instructions:

- Start by tying in the tail.
- Now tie in several rubber legs along the shank of the fly.
- Tie in hackle and chenille. Wrap chenille along the shank and making sure to leave the legs free.
- Wrap hackle forward up to the eye of the hook and whip finish.

Spratley Leech



Hook: 10-6 Nymph
Thread: 8/0 Olive
Tail: Olive marabou w/ a few strands of pearl flashabou
Body: Olive dazzle dubbing
Rib: Gold flat silver tinsel
Head: Copper or gold bead head

Tying Instructions:

- Slide bead head on to hook before placing in vice.
- Tie in marabou at bend of hook for tail. Tail should be about half the length of the shank of the hook.
- Tie in a few strands of flashabou on both sides of the marabou tail. Then trim to the same length as tail.
- Tie in flat tinsel.
- Dub the dazzle dubbing on to thread and wrap forward to the bead head.
- Whip finish and head cement.
- Pull out dubbing with a bodkin, make sure not to pull on the ribbing.

Starlite Leech

Hook: #4 - 1/0
Thread: Color to match head
Tail: Rabbit Strip
Body: Medium Crystal Chenille
Collar: Saddle Hackle
Head: Small Chenille
Eyes: Dumb Bell Eyes

Tying Instructions:

- Start by securely tying in the dumbbell eyes.
- Tie in Rabbit Strip at the bend of the hook.
- Tie in chenille and wrap up to the eyes.
- Tie in hackle behind the eyes and make about 4 wraps.
- Tie in colored chenille and figure 8 wrap it around the eyes, whip finish.

Starlite Leech

Hook: #4 - 1/0
Thread: Color to match head
Tail: Rabbit Strip
Body: Medium Crystal Chenille
Collar: Saddle Hackle
Head: Small Chenille
Eyes: Dumb Bell Eyes

Tying Instructions:

- Start by securely tying in the dumbbell eyes.
- Tie in Rabbit Strip at the bend of the hook.
- Tie in chenille and wrap up to the eyes.
- Tie in hackle behind the eyes and make about 4 wraps.
- Tie in colored chenille and figure 8 wrap it around the eyes, whip finish.
